


MetAnyier

A South Sudanese Australian woman, born in a refugee camp in Kenya, lost her parents as a child, migrated to Australia at age 10 and almost 20 years later, a force for greatness.

Anyier is energetic, warm and shares a common love for deep talks and sharing wisdom. She wants her audience in Australia and across the world to feel heard and feel inspired and take action to get the most out of life regardless of the struggle they have been through.





Over the years Anyier has provided consultation to local councils, state and national government agencies, schools and businesses on numerous issues on women and girls rights, refugee and gender equality, sport for development, youth participation and improving representation of minority groups in the Australian beauty and fashion industry. In addition to this, she regularly attends high level consultative meetings at the United Nations High Commission for Refugees (UNHCR) in Geneva, where she advocates for the experiences of refugee women to be included in all decisions and agreements.

Anyier is an inspiring young entrepreneur with aspirational dreams for social change. Anyier has been influential in her advocacy activities and creating a space where

young people are able to use their voice to bring change.

She has been successful in improving and promoting diversity in the beauty and fashion industry. More importantly, she passionately went above and beyond in promoting education and inclusion for young people, women and girls nationally and internationally.

Anyier is the former co-chair of the Young Women Advisory Group (Harmony Alliance) and member of the Harmony Alliance Council Committee team for 2018. In this role, she guides and facilitates advocacy and leadership training for young women from migrant and refugee backgrounds to better address the needs of their communities in Australia. These young women represent a diverse

range of industries and work with over 6000 refugees and migrants.

She is also the former chair of the Australian National Committee on Refugee Women (ANCORW) 2017-2020 and facilitates an annual consultation for over 100 refugee women and girls. The consultations are used for numerous local, national, regional and international advocacy opportunities. Anyier frequently represents ANCORW at the UNHCRNGO consultations and Global Refugee Summit in Geneva where she speaks on numerous issues.

Anyier works along two other areas of significant social impact, where she uses beauty pageants and sports to advocate for integration and inclusiveness. Navigating her adolescent years, Anyier grew a passion for the fashion industry.

Having some success competing in beauty pageants, Anyier was able to garner an audience both locally and internationally, motivating her to create her own national annual pageant and launching a modelling agency. Beauty pageants can sometimes be underestimated, Anyier seesit as a way to raise awareness about the lack of opportunities for women from African backgrounds in the modelling industry, and advocates for better opportunities for them. She is determined to encourage, inspire and support her fellow women to find and exceed their potential within the modelling world and all other facets of their lives and those around them.

Following this stream of work, she has founded Lead Beyond Education (LBE), a charitable organisation dedicated to providing life-changing opportunities through education, human rights advocacy and leadership capacity development to culturally and racially marginalised (CaRM) women and girls from underrepresented groups in Australia and refugee camps.

A testament to her dedication, Anyier was recently awarded the prestigious SBS & Australia for UNHCR Les Murray 2023 Award for Refugee Recognition. Her prominence extends to diverse media platforms, including print, radio, and television. She graced the ABC Daily Wrap with Tracey Holmen during the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023. She was prominently featured in the September 2023 issue of Marie Claire for her remarkable work through the Miss Sahara program.

Diversity and inclusion -How to support the practice of inclusion

Anyier draws from lived experience as a woman of colour and South Sudanese-Australian growing up being seen as the 'other'. Anyier believes diversity and inclusion can only be achieved if diversity, differences, and equity are truly valued in our society and workplace. In this keynote session, Anyier uses her knowledge and lived experience to call for action and encourage individuals and leaders to leverage the diversity of thinking to create a space that makes a systemic change.

Education and gender equality

Anyier has forged her path to success by completing her Bachelor's and Master's and now undertaking a PhD, once again, seeking to advance the opportunities for women through her research into challenges and inequalities women face in relationships involving bride price exchange traditions. Anyier Yuol collaborates with a range of stakeholders to amplify the voice of women in Western Sydney across Australia and the world over.
